



### Descriptive Biography

Dr. Mufti Mahmood Ahmad is the Professor and Head at the Department of Surgery, Government Medical College & SMHS Hospital, Srinagar. Hailing from a family with judicial background, father - Justice Mufti Baha-ud-din Farooqui, he was the first from his family to choose medicine as a profession. Since his early days at school (Burn Hall, Srinagar), he excelled at academics bagging the coveted National Scholarship for Outstanding Merit in 1977. He started his career in medicine by attaining MBBS degree (1980-1985) from GMC Srinagar and was awarded Gold Medal and Distinction for his outstanding performance during the curriculum. During his MS General Surgery training from 1991-1994 at GMC Srinagar, he developed a penchant for Urology. In pursuit of his admiration for urology he successfully qualified and completed MCH Urology (2001-2004) from the Institute of Medical Sciences at the famed Banaras Hindu University, in the process he has the feat, to his name, of being the only (till date) MCH Urology Scholar in GMCS from this premier university. His journey at GMC Srinagar started as Lecturer & Chief Urologist in the Department of Surgery in the year 2008. He is presently heading the Department as a Professor of Surgery. During his current tenure at GMC Srinagar he has the credit of many "firsts" to his name as he has performed various surgical procedures successfully for the first time here, like, PCNL, laparoscopic nephron preserving nephrectomy, mini PCNL, RIRS, trans urethral enucleation of prostate, ultra mini PCNL, flank free approach PCNL and endopyelotomy. As an academician he has been imparting surgical teaching to undergraduate MBBS students since past 25 years. Since his appointment as a post graduate guide in the year 2012, he has meticulously mentored more than 20 post graduate scholars in completing their academics, surgical training and thesis work. Till date, he has published more than 30 research articles in various journals of international repute. In the year 2003 he was awarded the prestigious "Marudhar Urology Trust Best Paper Award" for his paper "Staging of Bladder Carcinoma: MRI -Pathologic Correlation". He has been regularly presenting his research work as video presentations, how I do it, seminars and papers at various national and international conferences and workshops. In his pursuit of excellence as a surgeon and academician he has successfully completed various training and certified courses for advanced and basic laparoscopy (MISTC -AIIMS, New Delhi), recent advances in BHP (John Hopkins University- School of Medicine, USA) and laparoscopic surgery course (PSG Hospital & IMSRC, Coimbatore). He is a life time member of Urological Society of India, India Hernia Society and SELSI.
