**Terms and Conditions of the engagement:-**

- The applicants must be domiciles of UT of Jammu and Kashmir.
- This contractual engagement won't confer any right upon the hired persons for regular/permanent appointment. The contractual engagee shall have to furnish an affidavit duly attested by the 1<sup>st</sup> Class Magistrate to the effect that he/she will not claim for regular appointment at any future date on the strength of this contractual engagement.

3. The engagement will initially be made for one year and will be extended further subject to the satisfactory performance of the candidates/approval of the competent authority and:-
  - a. Availability of Budget/Funds.
  - b. Continuation of this Scheme.
4. The contractual engagee shall be paid monthly salary of Rs. 56000 plus HRA as per guidelines of the scheme.
5. The selected candidate shall have to execute an agreement to the effect that he/she will not leave the Department before the completion of one year's contract. However, abandonment/termination of the arrangement will require one month's prior notice on either side, failing which the salary shall not be paid for one month to the incumbent, which shall always remain in deposit with the Department and shall be released on the completion of sanctioned term.
