



I am directed to refer your proposal for Starting of MD(Respiratory Medicine) course at Government Medical College, Srinagar under University of Kashmir u/s 10A of the I.M.C Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21.

It is to inform that the Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's report (14/10/2019) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Srinagar under University of Kashmir for Starting of MD(Respiratory Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21 and decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's Report (14/10/2019) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) and decided to issue Letter of Permission for Starting of MD(Respiratory Medicine) course at Government Medical College, Srinagar under University of Kashmir u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2020-2021 restricting the number of admissions to 04(Four) students per year, the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956."

It is also to inform that the Board of Governors further decided that Letter of Permission for Starting of MD(Respiratory Medicine) course for 04(Four) seats as per available facilities, with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2020-21 at Government Medical College, Srinagar u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 may be issued.

In view of the above decision, the Council has decided to obtain undertaking/ essential documents for issue of Letter of Permission for starting/ increase in seats for the academic year 2020-21:-

1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
2. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Board of Governors is granted.

The Government Medical College, Srinagar should provide basic infrastructure facilities as per MCI norms. However, medical colleges institutions governed by the State are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their budget all the facilities fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.

6. The Board of Governors reserve the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Intent/Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained from Board of Governors by misrepresentation of fact or fraud.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified in the circular in this regards issued by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admission in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the college.

Action to grant formal permission of the Board of Governors for increased intake/starting of the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of appropriate bank guarantee, if applicable and undertaking/ compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated above. The acceptance letter may be sent within one month from the date of issue of this letter to enable the Board of Governors to issue Letter of Permission for the academic year 2020-21.

Sir,

I am directed to state that the Central Govt. has recently modified the teacher student ratio from 1:1 to 1:2 by amending the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000. Accordingly, the Health Secretaries of all the States were requested by MCI to direct the Deans/Principals of Govt. Medical Colleges in their respective States to send the information with regard to availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialities and availability of Professors & Associate Professors in respect of Super-specialities and also Unit wise number of teaching beds & students. The information received from your college was considered by the Postgraduate Committee of Medical Council of India at its meeting held on 26-27.2.2010 in the light of Gazette Notification dated 24.7.2009 and recommended to this Ministry to issue letter of permission for enhancement of seats in various postgraduate courses.


2. In view of the above, permission of the Central Government is granted for increase of seats in the following courses with annual intake mentioned against each course with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2010-11 at the college under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act, 1956:
