SRO 517. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir the Governor hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.
2. Definition: In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) 'Administrative Department' means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;
 - (b) 'Commission' means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
 - (c) 'Government' means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (d) 'Schedule' means the schedule, annexed to these rules;
 - (e) 'Service' means the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Service;
 - (f) 'State' means the State of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (g) Words and Expressions used in these rules but not defined, shall have the meaning as assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and appeals) Rules, 1956.
3. Constitution of the service and its classification:- (1) There shall be constituted the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Services with effect from the date of issue of these rules.
 - (2) The service shall comprise the following wings, namely:-
 - i/ Teaching;
 - ii/ Administrative, and
 - iii/ General.
 - (3) Each wing of the service shall consist of such posts, classes and categories and such member of them as may be determined by the Government from time to time; that at the commencement of these rules the service shall consist of the posts, classes and categories as specified in Schedule I.

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4. Members of the Service:- The members of the service shall be such persons as are appointed to the service under these rules;

Provided that the members of the service under the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1974, in force immediately before the commencement of these rules, shall be deemed to have been appointed to the corresponding posts, in the service, specified in Schedule II.

Explanation:- For purposes of this rule:-

- (a) members of the service under the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1974, shall mean persons appointed on regular basis on any post in that service and shall not include persons working on deputation, contract or adhoc basis on any post in that service; and
- (b) any person appointed to any post in the Service under these rules on deputation, contract, or adhoc basis shall not be a member of the service only by virtue of such deputation, contract or adhoc appointment.

5. Recruitment to the Service:- Appointment to the service, shall be made:-

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion, by selection; in the manner as indicated against each post in Schedule III.

6. Fixation of pay:-

- (a) A person appointed to the service by direct recruitment shall draw pay at the minimum of time scale of pay of the post to which he is appointed;

Provided that the initial pay on appointment to a post in the service of a person who, immediately before such appointment, held a post under the Government in the Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Service or in a substantive or an officiating capacity and drew his pay/presumptive pay equal to or higher than the minimum of the time scale of the former post, shall be regulated under Part. 77-B of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations; provided it involves assumption of higher responsibilities.

- (b) In the case of persons who are appointed under these rules by promotion by selection, their fixation of pay shall be regulated under the normal rules relating to such fixation from time to time.

7. Eligibility:- (1) A person shall not be eligible for recruitment/promotion to a post in the service unless he possess the qualifications and fulfill the requirements of recruitment prescribed for that post in the Schedule II.

Provided that the Commission may recommend, for consideration the Government, the appointment of a person to a post ~~in the~~ in the service who otherwise not eligible under these rules is, in the opinion of the commission, possessing exceptional merit as well as professional experience of high order in his speciality such a case will be considered by the Government after obtaining the views of the Medical Council of India.

(2) Without prejudice to the conditions of the eligibility prescribed in Schedule II, every person appointed to a post in the service shall be a permanent resident of the State;

Provided that where any permanent resident is not available for appointment to any post, the Government may appoint a non-permanent resident otherwise eligible for holding such post, on contract basis or on deputation for a term not exceeding three years as it may specify in the order.

Provided further that the Government shall have the power to renew the contract/deputation upto a maximum period of five years in suitable cases.

8. Method of recruitment:- While making selections:-
(1) to the posts in the teaching wing of the service, the Commission/Departmental Promotions Committee shall have regard to the following, namely:-

- (sa) Academic qualifications of the candidates;
- (b) Teaching experience;
- (c) Research experience and publication, and
- (d) previous record of work, if any.

(2) to the posts in the Administrative and General wings of the Service, the Commission/Departmental Promotion Committee shall have regard to the following, namely:-

- (a) Academic qualification;
- (b) Experience; and
- (c) Previous record of work, if any.

9. Age at recruitment:- (1) The upper age limit for a candidate for a post required to be filled up by direct recruitment shall be 32 years on the first day of January, of the year in which notice inviting applications for recruitment ~~such~~ post is issued by the Commission. This condition shall, however, not apply to persons appointed on contract/deputation basis.

(2) The upper age limit for persons belonging to the Jammu and Kashmir Medical (Gazetted) Service or to any other service under the Jammu and Kashmir Government shall be 45 years.

(3) The Government may relax the upper age limit in any suitable case or category of cases.

10. Seniority:- Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, control and appeal) Rules, 1953

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(2) The Administrative Department in the Civil Secretariat shall maintain an upto date Seniority list of the Service.

11. Reservation of appointment:- (1) While making appointments, either by promotion by selection or by direct recruitment, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for the members of the scheduled Castes or any other category or class of permanent residents of the state for whom such reservation may be made under the orders of the Government.

(2) If a sufficient number of candidates belonging to the classes for whom reservation has been made, are not available for filling up all or any of the vacancy reserved for them during a recruitment period, reservations for the posts not so filled shall lapse and the posts shall be filled up as if no reservation therefor had been made.

12. Disqualification:- No person,

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or,
- (b) who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person;

Shall be eligible for appointment to any post in the service;

Provided that the Government may if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

13. Probation:- Persons appointed to the service, either by direct recruitment or by promotional by Selection shall be on probation for two years and their confirmation in the service shall be regulated under the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and appeal) Rules, 1956.

14. Discipline and conduct: In regard to all matter governing the service conditions of the members of the service and their conduct and discipline, the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Government Employees (Conduct) Rules, the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations and the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and appeal) Rules, 1956 and other rules and orders in force at the time shall apply.

15. Conditions of Service: 1 Unless otherwise directed by the Government by any general or special order, no member of the service shall undertake private practice. Every such member shall be entitled to a monthly non-practicing allowance at such rate as may be determined by the Government from time to time.

(2) The Government may, in the exigencies of the public Service, temporarily post any member of the service to perform such duties as it may assign to him outside his service.

Provided that such posting shall not effect his membership of the service under these rules.

16. Residuary powers:- In regard to matters not specifically covered by these Rules or by the orders issued thereunder, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules and regulations applicable to the State Civil Services in general in so far as these are consistent with these rules.

17. Interpretation:- If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Government whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.

18. Repeal and saving:- (1) The Jammu and Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 1974 are hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment or order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Traumatology with allied Super Specialties, Srinagar, operational on an urgent basis, and further that there was an immediate need for making selection against the newly created posts of teaching faculty for these Super Specialties Hospitals in order to make them functional, vide Government Order No.181-HME of 2011 dated 15.03.2011, the minimum qualification and method of recruitment was prescribed for various teaching faculty posts in different super specialties of these two Super Specialty Hospitals;

AND WHEREAS, the above referred to Government Order No.181-HME of 2011 dated 15.03.2011, prescribes the method of recruitment to the posts of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor, 50% by direct recruitment and 50% by promotion and for the post of Lecturer, 100% by direct recruitment. However, it has been found that no direct recruitment has so far taken place against the posts of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in any of the disciplines, with the result, the higher faculty posts have mostly remained substantively vacant in many of the super specialties and are being manned either on academic arrangement basis or on internal arrangement basis by utilization of services of the faculty members from various departments of Government Medical Colleges, Srinagar/Jammu, possessing the requisite super specialty qualifications;

AND WHEREAS, it has also been found that the qualifications prescribed for direct recruitment/promotion to various categories of posts in many super specialties in the aforesaid Government Order do not match with the profile of that particular



post and are also not in tune with the qualifications prescribed by Medical Council of India for such type of posts and as such warrant revision;

AND WHEREAS, the matter has further been examined in the Department and it has been felt that it shall be appropriate to prescribe the minimum qualifications and method of recruitment in respect of various categories of faculty posts for the Super Specialty Hospitals, Srinagar and Jammu, afresh. It has also been decided to issue separate recruitment rules for the Super Specialty Hospitals, Srinagar and Jammu.

Now, therefore, in supersession of Government order No. 181-HME of 2011 dated 15.03.2011, issued under endorsement No.ME-GAZ-103/2010, so far as it pertains to Super Specialty Hospital, Srinagar, and pending finalization of recruitment rules, the minimum qualification for recruitment and method of recruitment for various categories of gazetted level posts and faculty posts in Super Specialty Hospital, Srinagar is hereby notified as per the details indicated in **Annexure-A** to this Government Order. A similar order in respect of Super Specialty Hospital, Jammu shall be issued separately.

WHEREAS, vide Government Order No. 70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, 343 posts for different categories have been created for 500 bedded new Paediatric Hospital (Government Medical College, Srinagar) at Bemina, Srinagar. These include faculty posts and other posts at the gazetted level;

AND WHEREAS, out of the above creations, posts have been created for the first time in the following Departments/Sub-Specialties of Paediatrics, which Departments/Sub-Specialties do not exist either in Government Medical College, Srinagar or in the Super Specialty Hospital, Srinagar:-

- i. Neonatology
- ii. Paediatric Anaesthesia
- iii. Paediatric Orthopaedics
- iv. Paediatric Cardiology
- v. Paediatric Neurology
- vi. Paediatric Gastroenterology
- vii. Paediatric Biochemistry

AND WHEREAS, besides above, posts have also been created in a new Discipline under the heading 'Neonatal Division LD Hospital, Srinagar' in terms of the above said creation order;

AND WHEREAS, a three tier faculty structure of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor has been created in the Discipline of Neonatology and other Sub-Specialties of the Department of Paediatrics referred to above but in the Neonatal Division, LD Hospital, a four tier faculty

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structure of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor and Lecturer has been created;

AND WHEREAS, In terms of the above creation order, posts have also been created in the Departments of General Paediatrics, Pathology and Pediatric Surgery. The Disciplines of General Paediatrics and Pathology already exist in Government Medical College, Srinagar and the Discipline of Paediatric Surgery, for which only the posts of Registrars and Medical Officers have been created this time, already exists in Super Specialty Hospital, Srinagar. Besides, among others, posts like Paediatric Ophthalmologist, Pediatric Hematologist, Paediatric Nephrologist, Paediatric Radiologist, Pediatric Microbiologist and Child Psychologist have earlier been created in GMC, Srinagar (G.B. Pant Children Hospital Srinagar), vide Government No.322-HME of 2006 dated 19.05.2006;

AND WHEREAS, since the Departments of General Paediatrics and Pathology already exist in GMC, Srinagar, the posts created for these Departments vide Government Order No. 70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020 can be added at appropriate levels in the said Disciplines of GMC, Srinagar. The qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment already exists in respect of these posts and no fresh qualifications/method of recruitment need to be notified in respect of such posts. Similarly, the Discipline of Paediatric Surgery already exists in Super Specialty Hospital, Srinagar and the qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment already exists in respect of the faculty posts and other gazetted level posts including the posts of Registrars and Medical Officers of the said Discipline, notified vide Government Order No.961-HME of 2019 dated 24.10.2019 and as such no fresh qualifications/method of recruitment need to be notified in respect of the posts of Registrar and Medical Officer created now for this Sub-Specialty, vide Government Order No. 70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020 and these posts can be added at appropriate levels in the said discipline of Super Specialty Hospital, Srinagar.

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AND WHEREAS, for the posts of Pediatric Ophthalmologist, Pediatric Hematologist, Pediatric Nephrologist, Pediatric Radiologist, Pediatric Microbiologist and Child Psychologist, which have been created earlier in Government Medical College, Srinagar (G. B. Pant Children Hospital, Srinagar) in the year 2006, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment has already been notified, vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 29.08.2012;

AND WHEREAS, since the posts of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor have also been created now for the above Pediatric Sub-Specialties in terms of Government Order No. 70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, the qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment need to be notified in respect of these newly created faculty posts also. However, for these Sub-Specialties, it has to be made as per the four tier faculty structure as the posts of Lecturers for these Sub-Specialties have already been created earlier in the year 2006. Besides the qualifications prescribed for direct recruitment for the posts of Lecturers for these Sub-Specialties, notified earlier vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 20.09.2012, also require to be modified/updated so as to maintain uniformity with the qualifications being prescribed now for the newly created three tier faculty level posts in various Paediatric Sub-Specialties;

AND WHEREAS, among others, a post of Lecturer in the Sub-Specialty of Pediatric Hematology has earlier been created in the year 2006 and the incumbent Lecturer is also in position in the Department of Paediatrics in GMC, Srinagar in this Sub-Specialty since December, 2012. However, in the fresh Creation Order No.70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, the posts of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Registrar and Medical Officer have been created for the Sub-Specialty of Paediatric Hematology/Oncology. Hematology and Oncology being two separate disciplines with different qualifications for recruitment and with different job profiles, it will be difficult to prescribe qualifications for recruitment if this Sub-



Specialty exists as the Sub-Specialty of Pediatric Hematology/Oncology. The matter would as such require to be taken up with the Finance Department for carrying out rectification for naming this Sub-Specialty as the Sub-Specialty of Pediatric Hematology only.

Now, therefore, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment for the faculty posts and other gazetted level posts, created vide Government Order No.70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, for the 500 bedded new Paediatric Hospital (Government Medical College, Srinagar), Bemina, Srinagar, in its various Departments/Sub-Specialties, are hereby notified as per the details indicated in Annexures 'A', 'B' & 'C' to this Government Order. Annexure-'C' also depicts the details of the posts of Paediatric Sub-Specialties/Child Psychologist created in the year 2006 (for G. B. Pant Hospital, Srinagar), for which the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment was notified vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 29.08.2012, which is being superseded now except for the post of Lecturer in Paediatric Haematology. However, notification of such qualifications for recruitment/promotion for the posts included in Annexure-'C', shall be without prejudice to the qualifications possessed by the Lecturers who have been appointed earlier in these Paediatric Sub-Specialties or as Child Psychologist, as per the qualifications prescribed vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 29.08.2012 and that these Lecturers shall be eligible for promotion to the higher faculty posts on the basis of the qualifications on which they were earlier appointed on the recommendations of the J&K Public Service Commission.
